DRUGS AND MEDICINES TERMS OF REFERENCE

Supply and Delivery of Drugs and Medicines to be used for the Health Emergency Management Staff (HEMS) Unit of the City Health Office for 2024 in the City of San Fernando, Pampanga subject to Ordering Agreement

I. BACKGROUND

Emergency Medicine is one of the most valuable types of medical practices in the world. Without Emergency Medicine, trauma patients would have no means to urgent care.

Emergency Medicine is important on the fact that we can immediately provide care to a patient in need as soon as someone calls. With HEMS personnel in ambulances when they arrive emergency care is given to the patient until they reach the professionals at the hospital. The HEMS are trained in their profession and greatly overworked but all for a good cause. While at the hospital the physicians go directly to work on the urgent patient whether they use what timeline they use which is airways, stop the blood, fix the problem. That mentality is the best efficient way to create survival. Let alone is emergency medicine extremely difficult and dangerous due to the fact that procedures on the daily basis can either save a life or take one.

The goals of medicine encompass the relief of pain and suffering, the promotion of health and the prevention of disease, the forestalling of death and promoting of a peaceful death, and the cure of disease when possible and the case of those who cannot be cured.

II. BUDGETARY REQUIREMENT

The budgetary requirement for the Supply and Delivery of Drugs and Medicines to be used for the Health Emergency Management Staff (HEMS) Unit of the City Health Office for 2024 in the City of San Fernando, Pampanga subject to Ordering Agreement is included in the **PPMP with the Ref. No. 2024-1132** and already included in the Annual Procurement Plan (APP) of the City Government, which is in the amount of **TWO HUNDRED FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDERED TWENTY FIVE PESOS (P 204,525.00).**

III. OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the Supply and Delivery of Drugs and Medicines to be used for the Health Emergency Management Staff of the City Health Office for 2024 in the City of San Fernando, Pampanga subject to Ordering Agreement are as follows:

- 1. To relieve pain and suffering.
- 2. To promote health and prevent disease.
- 3. To provide first aid to emergency cases.

IV.TERMS AND CONDITIONS

During the procurement process and delivery/ implementation of the contract, the end- user and the supplier/ contractor shall:

a. Specifications/ Schedule of Requirements
 The expiration date of the medicines requested should be at least TWO (2) YEARS OR TWENTY
 FOUR (24) MONTHS upon delivery and should be in good condition and packaging. In case the expiration date of the medicine does not meet the requirement needed, the supplier should

replace the medicine at least 3 months before its expiration date. All medicines to be delivered should have a Certificate of Product Registration (CPR) and Certificate of Analysis (CoA) and the expiration dates and lot numbers or batch numbers should tally with the medicine delivered.

b. Procurement Process

- 1. For the End- user, ensure the completion of the documents in order to proceed with the procurement process.
- 2. For the supplier/ provider, ensure the completeness of the documents being required by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) for the procurement process on- time based on the procurement schedule including this TOR duly signed by the end- user and conformed by the supplier/ contractor.
- 3. If the procurement process reaches the ensuing year, observe that the allowed transaction is only up to what is stipulated in the contract.
- 4. For the End- user, present clearly this TOR during the Pre- Bid Conference for the information of the prospective bidder/s (for Competitive/ Public Bidding), and present by the Buyer with the assistance of the End- user (for Alternative Methods of Procurement).
- 5. Ensure to supply the requirements upon issuance of DOC.
- 6. Comply with the provisions of the Procurement Law regardless of the mode of procurement, whether Competitive/ Public Bidding or the use of Alternative Methods of Procurement.

c. Delivery/ Implementation period

- 1. Strictly observe the "No Purchase Order (PO)/ Delivery Order Contract (DOC), No Delivery" Policy and comply with the delivery period.
- 2. The Delivery Period shall be from February 2024
- 3. During the delivery, strictly follow the provisions enumerated in the Terms and Condition of the PO/ Contract including the Delivery Schedule, Penalty, among others.
- 4. In case there is a change in the Delivery Schedule and specifications, the End- user through the Procurement Officer shall coordinate with the CGSO- Procurement Management Division (PMD) for the latter to advise the supplier/ contractor regarding the concern.
- 5. Coordination with the supplier/ contractor shall be the function of the CGSO- PMD as its mandate.

d. Inspection and Acceptance

- 1. The CGSO- PSMD shall inspect and accept the delivery provided that all the specifications/description of item requested are complied.
- 2. The supplier/contractor shall present the PO and issue Sales Invoice.
- 3. The CGSO- PSMD shall prepare the corresponding Inspection and Acceptance Report/s.

Such documents will be used in notifying the concerned offices on the delivery such as the City Accountant's Office (CAccO) and Commission on Audit (COA) to include the same in the Payables.

V.DELIVERABLES BY THE SUPPLIER/ CONTRACTOR AND THE CITY GOVERNMENT

The deliverables of the supplier/ contractor shall be as follows:

a. Provide the quantity of the medicines being required by the project/ program; and

b. Strictly follow the specifications and timely provision of requirements based on the delivery schedule.

The deliverables of the City Government shall be as follows:

- a. On-time payment of the supplier/contractor i.e., 15 days after the delivery.
- b. End- user shall monitor the delivery.
- c. The Procurement Officer shall assist in the monitoring and on-time payment of the supplier/contractor.
- d. Provide necessary and readily- available documents such as during the conduct of post- audit.
- e. Evaluate the performance of the supplier/ contractor and in case there is a violation to the Contract/ Agreement, prepare a Verified Report.
