TERMS OF REFERENCE

SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF TRAINING SUPPLIES TO BE USED FOR THE ROPE RESCUE TRAINING COURSE FOR RESPONDERS 2024 (BATCH 1 AND 2) IN THE CITY OF SAN FERNANDO, PAMPANGA

I.BACKGROUND

The training on Ropemanship, Rappelling and High Angle Rescue will allow San Fernando Rescue Unit (SAFRU) responders to enhance their technical skills on basic rope rescue techniques such as advanced knot tying, hauling system, descending techniques, tyrolean traverse, and single rope techniques. Although the City of San Fernando may not have mountainous terrain and high elevated areas, various buildings and high-rise establishments and structures have been erected in the city, brought about by urbanization which, in turn, may bring hazard to the community when disaster strikes.

For this training, the SAFRU will go back to the basics and will familiarize and practice mechanical advantages and other skills on a first-hand basis. The learning acquired during the training will be very essential to outdoor activities and deployment during rescue operations.

II.BUDGETARY REQUIREMENT

The Budgetary Requirement for the Supply and Delivery of Training Supplies to be used for the Rope Rescue Training Course for Responders 2024 (Batch 1 and 2) in the City of San Fernando, Pampanga, is included in the PPMP in the amount of ONE HUNDRED TEN THOUSAND PESOS (P 110, 000.00)

III.OBJECTIVES

- To enhance their technical skills on basic rope rescue techniques
- To provide and supply the specific materials needed during the training
- To effectively and efficiently conduct the activity/program.

IV.TERMS AND CONDITIONS

During the procurement process and delivery/ implementation of the contract, the end-user and the supplier/ contractor shall:

a. Specifications/ Schedule of Requirements

b. Procurement Process

- 1. For the End-user, ensure the completion of the documents in order to proceed with the procurement process.
- 2. For the supplier/provider, ensure the completeness of the documents being required by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) for the procurement process on- time based on the procurement schedule including this TOR duly signed by the end-user and conformed by the supplier/contractor.
- 3. If the procurement process reaches the ensuing year, observe that the allowed delivery is only up to what is stipulated in the contract.
- 4. Ensure to supply the requirements upon issuance of DOC.

5. Comply with the provisions of the Procurement Law regardless of the mode of procurement, whether Competitive/Public Bidding or the use of Alternative Methods of Procurement.

c. Delivery/ Implementation period

- 1. Strictly observe the "No Purchase Order (PO)/ Delivery Order Contract (DOC), No Delivery" Policy and comply with the delivery period.
- 2. The Delivery Period shall be from June-September 2024.
- 3. During the delivery, strictly follow the provisions enumerated in the Terms and Condition of the PO/ Contract including the Delivery Schedule, Penalty, among others.
- 4. In case there is a change in the Delivery Schedule and specifications, the End- user through the Procurement Officer shall coordinate with the CGSO-Procurement Management Division (PMD) for the latter to advise the supplier/contractor regarding the concern.
- 5. Coordination with the supplier/ contractor shall be the function of the CGSO-PMD as its mandate.
- 6. For onsite delivery, ensure the coordination with the Inspector from the CGSO-Property and Supply Management Division (PSMD) for the inspection of the delivery in terms of quantity and quality and to immediately notify the supplier/contractor in case of any concerns before the acceptance.

d. Inspection and Acceptance

- 1. The CGSO-PSMD shall inspect and accept the delivery
- 2. The supplier/contractor shall present the PO and issue Sales Invoice
- 3. The CGSO-PMD shall prepare the corresponding Inspection and Acceptance Report/s.

V.DELIVERABLES BY THE SUPPLIER/ CONTRACTOR AND THE CITY GOVERNMENT

The deliverables of the supplier/ contractor shall be as follows:

- a. Provide the quantity of training supplies required by the project/ program; and
- b. Strictly follow the specifications and timely provision of requirements based on the delivery schedule.

The deliverables of the City Government shall be as follows:

- a. On- time payment of the supplier/ contractor i.e., 15 days after the month.
- b. End- user shall monitor the delivery of requirements.
- c. The Procurement Officer shall assist in the monitoring, delivery and on-time payment of the supplier.
- d. Provide necessary and readily-available documents such as during the conduct of post-
- e. Evaluate the performance of the supplier/contractor and in case there is a violation to the Contract/Agreement, prepare a Verified Report.
