#### TERMS OF REFERENCE

#### SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF MEALS TO BE SERVED FOR THE ASLAG NING BALEN COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT AND ENGAGEMENT PROGRAM (COMMUNITY EXTENSION PROGRAM) OF THE CITY COLLEGE OF SAN FERNANDO PAMPANGA

#### **LBACKGROUND**

Extension Services is one of the major functions of a higher education institution (HEI). The City College of San Fernando, Pampanga (CCSFP) as an HEI, is aiming to implement extension services beyond its traditional form as it has embraced community engagement framework in setting its strategic direction as a leading institution of higher education advancing the quality of life of Fernandinos.

Discroll (2009) defines Community Engagement as the collaboration between higher education institution and their larger communities (local, regional/state, national, global) for the mutually beneficial exchange of knowledge and resources in the context of partnership and reciprocity. By strengthening extension services through community engagement, CCSFP will enrich scholarship, research and creative activity of the faculty; enhance the overall school curriculum, teaching and learning which are more attuned to surrounding communities; and, prepare students to become well-rounded and engaged citizens.

The RESO, through its ABCEE program, will partner with the 3 barangays (Alasas, San Isidro and Del Rosario) hosting the main campus of the City College. Barangay Alasas will be the first to commence this year with community profiling, needs assessment and community development planning activities. Implementation of the approved CDP could take about 3 years prior to evaluation and termination.

#### ILBUDGETARY REQUIREMENT

The Budgetary Requirement for the Supply and Delivery of Meals to be served for the Aslag ning Balen Community Empowerment and Engagement Program (Community Extension Program) of the City College of San Fernando Pampanga is included in the PPMP with Ref No. 2024-2150 and already included in the Annual Procurement Plan (APP) of the City Government, which is in the amount of EIGHTY ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY PESOS ONLY (PHP 81,680.00).

#### **III.OBJECTIVES**

The objectives of the Supply and Delivery of Meals to be served for the Aslag ning Balen Community Empowerment and Engagement Program (Community Extension Program) of the City College of San Fernando Pampanga are as follows:

- To advocate for community engagement and mobilize support for CE activities

#### b. Procurement Process

 For the End- user, ensure the completion of the documents in order to proceed with the procurement process.

 For the supplier/ provider, ensure the completeness of the documents being required by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) for the procurement process on- time based on the procurement schedule including this TOR duly signed by the end- user and conformed by the supplier/ provider.

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- If the procurement process reaches the ensuing year, observe that the allowed delivery is only up to what is stipulated in the contract.
- For the End- user, present clearly this TOR during the Pre- Bid Conference for the information of the prospective bidder/s (for Competitive/ Public Bidding), and present by the Buyer with the assistance of the End- user (for Alternative Methods of Procurement).
- Ensure that there are readily- available supplies upon submission of Request for Ouotation (RFO)/ Bid since delivery is anticipated upon issuance of PO/ Contract.
- Comply with the provisions of the Procurement Law regardless of the mode of procurement, whether Competitive/ Public Bidding or the use of Alternative Methods of Procurement.
- c. Delivery/ Implementation period
- Strictly observe the "No Purchase Order (PO)/ Contracts, No Delivery" Policy and comply with the delivery period.
- 2. The Delivery Period shall be May December 2024.
- During the delivery, strictly follow the provisions enumerated in the Terms and Condition of the PO/ Contract including the Delivery Schedule, Penalty, among others.
- 4. In case there is a change in the Delivery Schedule and specifications, the End-user through the Procurement Officer shall coordinate with the CGSO- Procurement Management Division (PMD) for the latter to advise the supplier/ contractor regarding the concern.
- Coordination with the supplier/ contractor shall be the function of the CGSO- PMD as its mandate.
- 6. For onsite delivery, ensure the coordination with the Inspector from the CGSO- Property and Supply Management Division (PSMD) for the inspection of the delivery in terms of quantity and quality of meals and to immediately notify the supplier/ contractor in case of any concerns before the acceptance.
- d. Inspection and Acceptance
  - The End- user shall accept the delivery with one (1) delivery receipt, and submit immediately to the Inspector or CGSO- PSMD together with two (2) attendance sheet/s as part of the utilization where the quantity of the delivery is the same as the number of attendees and photo documentation of the delivery.

Such documents will be used in notifying the concerned offices on the delivery such as the City Accountant's Office (CAccO) and Commission on Audit (COA) to include the same in the Payables.

# V,DELIVERABLES BY THE SUPPLIER/ CONTRACTOR AND THE CITY GOVERNMENT

The deliverables of the supplier/ contractor shall be as follows:

- a. Provide the quantity of meals being required by the project/ program;
- b. Provide the menu and of quality as requested by the end user; and

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Strictly follow the specifications and timely provision of requirements based on the delivery schedule.

the deliverables of the City Government shall be as follows:

- a. On- time payment of the supplier/ contractor i.e., 15 days after delivery regardless if the delivery is per month or Ordering Agreement.
- b. End- user shall monitor the delivery of requirements
- c. The Procurement Officer shall assist in the monitoring, delivery and on-time payment of the supplier.
- d. Provide necessary and readily- available documents such as during the conduct of postaudit.
- Evaluate the performance of the supplier/ contractor and in case there is a violation to the Contract/ Agreement, prepare a Verified Report.
