OFFICE: CITY AGRICULTURE AND VETERINARY OFFICE

PROJECT: Supply and Delivery of Hybrid Yellow Corn Seeds to be given to the Fernandino Farmers inline with the Food Production and Seed Subsidy for 2024 in the City of San Fernando, Pampanga

DATE: September 2024

BACKGROUND

Corn is a centrally important crop, both to local communities and the global food system. As the world's most dominant and productive crop, with extensive areas of land dedicated to global production yields of over 1 billion metric tons, corn is used for a variety of purposes — including animal feed, grain for human consumption, ethanol, as well as for high fructose corn syrup, sweeteners, starch, and for beverage/alcohol production.

Through the devolution and implementation of the 1991 Local Government Code, the City Agriculture and Veterinary Office as an instrument to promote sustainable development and address related problems of poverty, inequity and food security and food affordability and way of encouraging local farmers to continue producing food despite all these challenges through the provision of high quality certified seeds to safeguard food availability through increased crop yield and production that years onwards the City will be self-sufficient in rice, hence boost the City's economy.
