TERMS OF REFERENCE

CONTRACT OF SERVICE FOR THE DRUG TESTING OF PARTICIPANTS IN RELATION TO THE BAHAY PAGBABAGO OPERATIONS AND MONITORING PROGRAM (CONDUCT OF 30 DAY REFORMATION PROGRAM FOR DRUG SURRENDEREES FOR 2024 IN THE CITY OF SAN FERNANDO, PAMPANGA SUBJECT TO ORDERING AGREEMENT

I. BACKGROUND

Pursuant to R.A. No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 particularly Section 444(b)(1) provides that the Chief Executive shall exercise general supervision and control over all programs, projects, services, and activities of the local government.

In the City Government of San Fernando, Pampanga through its police force, City of San Fernando Police Station, remains vigilant in its fight against any issues on illegal drugs. This is a very serious matter and life-endangering which needs utmost attention and intervention for the youth who are called to be the hope of our country and are the most vulnerable sector of our society. The issues on illegal drugs which very serious in our country. The War on Drugs of His Excellency President Rodrigo R. Duterte is an effective and powerful tool which led to many drug users and pushers voluntarily surrender in their respective barangays/municipalities or cities. However, despite of surrendering voluntarily, some of drug reformists are not totally healed and have not abstained or totally stopped in using these illegal drugs. It is very difficult for them because of reasons such as staying in the same environment that could make them even more vulnerable in continuing the use of illegal drugs and also there is no suitable facility in the City of San Fernando to cater drug surrenderees. People become more vulnerable especially when they are not aware of what triggers them into relapse. Continuous use of illegal drugs may lead to drug dependence, legal offenses, serious medical problems and even death.

To address the problem on illegal drug use and in support to anti-illegal drugs advocacy, the Local Government Unit initiated the construction of a BAHAY PAGBABAGO Reformation Center and now converted to Balay Silangan where the qualified drug surrenderees (Pusher) of the City will stay for one month or up until he has been treated for drug dependence and ready to reintegration to the community. The center operates on the spirit of volunteerism without expenses and also it is purposely created to help drug dependents get over their addiction and help the community in preventing the uprising issues on illegal drug use. According to Section 51 of RA 9165 or Local Government Unit's Assistance, stating that **“Local Government Units shall appropriate a substantial portion of their respective annual budget to enhance the enforcement of this Act giving priority to preventive or educational programs, and the rehabilitation or treatment of drug dependents”**. The city government allocated funds for the community drug abuse rehabilitation program to effectively implement the services. This is to strongly support the mandate from the national government on war against drugs.

In compliance with the above, the City of San Fernando Police Station is proposing Contract of service for the drug testing of participants in relation to the Bahay Pagbabago Operations and Monitoring Program (conduct of 30 day reformation program for drug surrenderees for 2024 in the City of San Fernando, Pampanga subject to ordering agreement.

II. BUDGET REQUIREMENT

The Budgetary requirement for the Contract of service for the drug testing of participants in relation to the Bahay Pagbabago Operations and Monitoring Program (conduct of 30 day reformation program for drug surrenderees for 2024 in the City of San Fernando, Pampanga subject to ordering agreement is included in the PPMP with the Ref. No. **2024-2696** and already included in the Annual Procurement Plan (APP) of the City Government, which is in the amount of **FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY PESOS (P 460, 250.00)**.

III. OBJECTIVES

The objectives for the Contract of service for the drug testing of participants in relation to the Bahay Pagbabago Operations and Monitoring Program (conduct of 30 day reformation program for drug surrenderees for 2024 in the City of San Fernando, Pampanga are as follows:

1. To determined the prevalence of drug users, deter the use of illegal drugs and strengthen the collaboration efforts of identified agencies against the use of illegal drugs and in the rehabilitation of drug users and dependents.
2. To inform the Station with the result of the service conducted.

IV. SCOPE OF THE SERVICES

1. Ensure the confidentiality and legality of drug test result of the drug surrenderees .
2. Provide billing statement of drug test of the drug surrenderees for every transaction.

V. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

During the procurement process and delivery/ implementation of the contract, the end- user and the supplier/ contractor shall:

- a. Specifications/ Schedule of Requirements

- b. Procurement Process

1. For the End- user, ensure the completion of the documents in order to proceed with the procurement process.
2. For the supplier/ provider, ensure the completeness of the documents being required by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) for the procurement process on- time based on the procurement schedule including this TOR duly signed by the end- user and conformed by the supplier/ contractor.
3. If the procurement process reaches the ensuing year, observe that the allowed transaction is only up to what is stipulated in the contract.
4. For the End- user, present clearly this TOR during the Pre- Bid Conference for the information of the prospective bidder/s (for Competitive/ Public Bidding), and present by the Buyer with the assistance of the End- user (for Alternative Methods of Procurement).
5. Ensure to supply the requirements upon issuance of DOC.
6. Comply with the provisions of the Procurement Law regardless of the mode of procurement, whether Competitive/ Public Bidding or the use of Alternative Methods of Procurement.

- c. Delivery/ Implementation period

1. Strictly observe the “No Purchase Order (PO)/ Delivery Order Contract (DOC), No Delivery” Policy and comply with the delivery period.
2. The Delivery Period shall be from August to December 2024.

3. During the delivery, strictly follow the provisions enumerated in the Terms and Condition of the PO/ Contract including the Delivery Schedule, Penalty, among others.
4. In case there is a change in the Delivery Schedule and specifications, the End- user through the Procurement Officer shall coordinate with the CGSO- Procurement Management Division (PMD) for the latter to advise the supplier/ contractor regarding the concern.
5. Coordination with the supplier/ contractor shall be the function of the CGSO- PMD as its mandate.

d. Inspection and Acceptance

1. The End- user shall inform the CGSO- PSMD of the delivery for the latter to conduct inspection prior to the acceptance of the former.
2. The supplier/ contractor through the end- user, shall provide the CGSO- PSMD with the proof of publication and issue delivery receipt or Sales Invoice.

Such documents will be used in notifying the concerned offices on the transaction such as the City Accountant's Office (CAccO) and Commission on Audit (COA) to include the same in the Payables.

VI. DELIVERABLES BY THE SUPPLIER/ CONTRACTOR AND THE CITY GOVERNMENT

The deliverables of the supplier/ contractor shall be as follows:

- a. Provide the quantity (number of drug test conducted) required by the project/ program; and
- b. Strictly follow the specifications and timely provision of requirements based on the delivery schedule.

The deliverables of the City Government shall be as follows:

- a. On- time payment of the supplier/ contractor i.e., 15 days after the month.
- b. End- user shall monitor the transaction.
- c. The Procurement Officer shall assist in the monitoring and on- time payment of the supplier.
- d. Provide necessary and readily- available documents such as during the conduct of post- audit.
- e. Evaluate the performance of the supplier/ contractor and in case there is a violation to the Contract/ Agreement, prepare a Verified Report.
