TERMS OF REFERENCE

Supply and Delivery of Bottled Water to be served during the Values Education through Spiritual Transformation (VEST- World Teachers' Day Celebration) of the City Schools Division of San Fernando, Pampanga

I. RATIONALE:

Rationale:

The "Values Education through Spiritual Transformation (VEST)" training is a unique initiative designed to blend the celebration of World Teachers' Day with a deep dive into values education. Recognizing that teachers are the cornerstone of moral and ethical development in students, this event aims to strengthen the spiritual foundation of educators while honoring their invaluable contributions.

In today's rapidly changing world, educators face unprecedented challenges in maintaining their moral compass and instilling values in their students. This training will serve as a platform for teachers to reconnect with their spiritual beliefs, reflect on their roles as moral guides, and rejuvenate their commitment to values-based education. By integrating spiritual transformation with the celebration of World Teachers' Day, we aim to honor teachers not only for their professional achievements but also for their role in shaping the character and values of future generations.

This dual approach ensures that while teachers are recognized and celebrated for their hard work, they also receive the necessary spiritual and moral support to continue their vital work with renewed vigor and inspiration.

II. Objectives:

IV. BUDGETARY REQUIREMENT

b. Procurement Process

- 1. For the End- user, ensure the completion of the documents in order to proceed with the procurement process.
- 2. For the supplier/ provider, ensure the completeness of the documents being required by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) for the procurement process

on- time based on the procurement schedule including this TOR duly signed by the end- user and conformed by the supplier/ contractor.

- 3. If the procurement process reaches the ensuing year, observe that the allowed transaction is only up to what is stipulated in the contract.
- 4. For the End- user, present clearly this TOR during the Pre- Bid Conference for the information of the prospective bidder/s (for Competitive/ Public Bidding), and present by the Buyer with the assistance of the End- user (for Alternative Methods of Procurement).
- 5. Ensure to supply the requirements upon issuance of PO/DOC.
- Comply with the provisions of the Procurement Law regardless of the mode of procurement, whether Competitive/ Public Bidding or the use of Alternative Methods of Procurement

c. Delivery/ Implementation period

- Strictly observe the "No Purchase Order (PO)/ Delivery Order Contract (DOC), No Delivery"/No Job Order Policy and comply with the delivery period.
- Coordination with the supplier/ contractor shall be the function of the CGSO- PMD as its mandate.

d. Inspection and Acceptance

- 1. The CGSO- PSMD representative must be present during the activity proper.
- 2. The supplier/contractor shall issue a Sales Invoice or billing statement.
- The CGSO- PSMD shall prepare the corresponding Inspection and Acceptance Report/s.

Such documents will be used to notify the concerned offices on the delivery such as the City Accountant's Office (CAccO) and Commission on Audit (COA) to include the same in the Payables.

VI. DELIVERABLES BY THE SUPPLIER/ CONTRACTOR AND THE CITY GOVERNMENT

The deliverables of the supplier/ contractor shall be as follows:

- a. Ensure the availability and readiness of the bottled water before the activity date.
- b. Delivery shall be made on the day of the activity, 8 am of Oct. 4, 2024 at Bren Z. Guiao Convention Center.
- c. Distribution list will be given to the supplier and pack the bottled water per box/Big Plastic Bag according to the quantity per school, and label the box/plastic bag per school.

- Delivery shall be made on the day of the activity, 8 am of Oct. 4, 2024 at Bren Z.
 Guiao Convention Center.
- c. Distribution list will be given to the supplier and pack the meals per box according to the quantity per school, and also label the box per school.
- d. Provide additional paper bags for distribution to guests.
- e. Provide garbage bags for waste materials after the event.
- f. Provision of Assistant personnel to help us in the distribution.
- g. Issue Sales Invoice or Billing Statement.

The deliverables of the Schools Division Office shall be as follows:

- a. On-time payment of the supplier/ contractor i.e., 30 days after the delivery.
- b. End- user shall monitor the payment.
- c. The Procurement Officer shall assist in the monitoring and on-time payment of the supplier/ contractor.
- d. Provide necessary and readily- available documents such as during the conduct of post- audit.
- e. Evaluate the performance of the supplier/ contractor and in case there is a violation to the Contract/ Agreement, prepare a Verified Report.
