TERMS OF REFERENCE

SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF MEALS TO BE SERVED FOR THE STATE OF THE CHILDREN'S REPORT ON NOVEMBER 2024 IN THE CITY OF SAN FERNANDO, PAMPANGA

I.BACKGROUND

The Local Council for the Protection of Children (LCPC) as a local and community-based institution can be valuable and strategic mechanisms for the efficient and effective implementation of policies, programs, and projects on all the major areas of concern for children, thus, guidance and support must be provided to all stakeholders so that LCPCs can be strengthened, and their full potential can be harnessed.

The Department of Interior and Local Government thru its Memorandum Circular 2021-039 mandates all LCPC to conduct advocacy activities on the promotion and protection of the rights and welfare of children including the development of information, education, and advocacy materials. LCPC are also mandated to conduct capability-building activities for all stakeholders on children including in the barangay level.

The Local State of the Children's Report shall be prepared annually by the city government to provide critical data and information on the situation of children and the extent to which children's rights to health, nutrition, education, special protection and participation are promoted, respected, protected and fulfilled by the LGU.

The annual Local State of the Children's Report shall follow as closely as possible the organization of State Party's periodic reports on CRC implementation as prescribed by the UN Committee on the Rights of the Child in its Revised General Guidelines dated November 29, 2005 (CRC/C/58. Rev.1).

The report shall be organized following the cluster of child rights as follows: (a) civil rights and freedom, (b) family environment and alternative care, © basic health and welfare, (d) education, leisure and cultural activities, and (e) special protection measures. In addition to the clusters of substantive rights, the report will include sections on general principles and general measures of implementation.

II. BUDGETARY REQUIREMENT

The Budgetary Requirement for the Supply and Delivery of Meals to be served for the State of the Children's Report on November 2024 in the City of San Fernando, Pampanga is included in the PPMP with Ref. No. 2024-2266 and already included in the Annual Procurement Plan (APP) of the City Government, which is in the amount of **TWO HUNDRED NINETY THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED PESOS (PHP 290,800.00).**

III.OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the Supply and Delivery of Meals to be served for the State of the Children's Report on November 2024 in the City of San Fernando, Pampanga are as follows:

- 1. To ensure that the meals are served during the State of the Children's Report on November 2024 to be conducted in a conducive place;
- 2. To ensure continuous efficiency and active participation of the members in carrying out their duties and responsibilities in sustaining their organization.

3. To ensure that the children will have a venue or platform to express themselves and facilitate planning for the next year's activity for them and Fernandino children.

IV.TERMS AND CONDITIONS

During the procurement process and delivery/ implementation of the contract, the end-user and the supplier/ contractor shall:

c. Procurement Process

- 1. For the End- user, ensure the completion of the documents in order to proceed with the procurement process.
- 2. For the supplier/ provider, ensure the completeness of the documents being required by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) for the procurement process on- time based on the procurement schedule including this TOR duly signed by the end- user and conformed by the supplier/ provider.
- 3. If the procurement process reaches the ensuing year, observe that the allowed delivery is only up to what is stipulated in the contract.
- 4. For the End- user, present clearly this TOR during the Pre- Bid Conference for the information of the prospective bidder/s (for Competitive/ Public Bidding), and present by the Buyer with the assistance of the End- user (for Alternative Methods of Procurement).
- 5. Ensure that there are readily- available supplies upon submission of Request for Quotation (RFQ)/ Bid since delivery is anticipated upon issuance of PO/ Contract.
- 6. Comply with the provisions of the Procurement Law regardless of the mode of procurement, whether Competitive/ Public Bidding or the use of Alternative Methods of Procurement.

d. Delivery/Implementation period

- 1. Strictly observe the "No Purchase Order (PO)/ Contracts, No Delivery" Policy and comply with the delivery period.
- 2. The Delivery Period shall be on 2024.
- 3. During the delivery, strictly follow the provisions enumerated in the Terms and Condition of the PO/ Contract including the Delivery Schedule, Penalty, among others.

- 4. In case there is a change in the Delivery Schedule and specifications, the End- user through the Procurement Officer shall coordinate with the CGSO- Procurement Management Division (PMD) for the latter to advise the supplier/ contractor regarding the concern.
- 5. Coordination with the supplier/ contractor shall be the function of the CGSO- PMD as its mandate.
- 6. For onsite delivery, ensure the coordination with the Inspector from the CGSO-Property and Supply Management Division (PSMD) for the inspection of the delivery in terms of quantity and quality of meals and to immediately notify the supplier/ contractor in case of any concerns before the acceptance.

e. Inspection and Acceptance

1. The End- user shall accept the delivery with the (1) delivery receipts and submit immediately to the Inspector or CGSO- PSMD together with the (2) attendance sheet/s as part of the utilization where the quantity of the delivery is the same as the number of attendees and photo documentation of the delivery.

Such documents will be used in notifying the concerned offices on the delivery such as the City Accountant's Office (CAccO) and Commission on Audit (COA) to include the same in the Payables.

V. DELIVERABLES BY THE SUPPLIER/ CONTRACTOR AND THE CITY GOVERNMENT

The deliverables of the supplier/contractor shall be as follows:

- a. Provide the quantity of the meals being required by the project/ program; and
- Strictly follow the specifications and timely provision of requirements based on the delivery schedule.

The deliverables of the City Government shall be as follows:

- a. On-time payment of the supplier/contractor i.e., 15 days after delivery regardless of if the delivery is per month or Ordering Agreement.
- b. End- user shall monitor the delivery of requirements.
- c. The Procurement Officer shall assist in the monitoring, delivery and on-time payment of the supplier.
- d. Provide necessary and readily- available documents such as during the conduct of postaudit.
- e. Evaluate the performance of the supplier/ contractor and in case there is a violation to the Contract/ Agreement, prepare a Verified Report.
