TERMS OF REFERENCE

SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF MEALS TO BE SERVED DURING THE ACTIVITY TO INCREASE COMMUNITY AWARENESS REGARDING BE CAREFUL LECTURES AND SEMINARS ON LAWS PROTECTING THE RIGHTS OF WOMEN AND THEIR CHILDREN FOR 2025 IN THE CITY OF SAN FERNANDO, PAMPANGA SUBJECT TO ORDERING AGREEMENT

I.BACKGROUND

Pursuant to R.A. No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 particularly Section 444(b)(1) provides that the Chief Executive shall exercise general supervision and control over all programs, projects, services, and activities of the local government.

Child abuse, sexual and domestic violence are among the most destructive experiences afflicting women and children. Violence against women and children is a serious public health concern, with costs at multiple levels of society. Although violence is a threat to everyone, women and children are particularly susceptible to victimization because they often have fewer rights or lack appropriate means of protection.

Sexual violence is a serious problem that can have lasting, harmful effects on victims and their family, friends, and communities. It is quite alarming the increase of rape incidents in the event of pandemic wherein relatives were mostly the perpetrator.

.II.BUDGETARY REQUIREMENT

The Budgetary Requirement for the Supply and Delivery of Meals to be served during the activity to Increase Community Awareness regarding BE CAREFUL Lectures and Seminars on Laws protecting the rights of women and their children for 2024 in the City of San Fernando, Pampanga subject to Ordering Agreement is included in the PPMP with Ref. No. 2025-1431 and already included in the Annual Procurement Plan (APP) of the City Government, which is in the amount of ONE HUNDRED FORTY-NINE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SEVEN PESOS (P 149, 987.00).

III. OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the Supply and Delivery of Meals to be served during the activity to Increase Community Awareness regarding BE CAREFUL Lectures and Seminars on Laws protecting the rights of women and their children for 2025 in the City of San Fernando, Pampanga subject to ordering agreement are as follows:

1. To ensure that meals are served during the session considering that it is a policy of the City Government that provision of meals is allowed if the duration of the session is more than four (4) hours; and

2. To ensure the continuous efficiency and active participation of the Committee.

IV. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

During the procurement process and delivery/ implementation of the contract, the end-user and the supplier/ contractor shall:

a. Specifications/ Schedule of Requirements

b. Procurement Process

- 1. For the End- user, ensure the completion of the documents in order to proceed with the procurement process.
- For the supplier/ provider, ensure the completeness of the documents being required by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) for the procurement process on- time based on the procurement schedule including this TOR duly signed by the end- user and conformed by the supplier/ contractor.
- 3. If the procurement process reaches the ensuing year, observe that the allowed delivery is only up to what is stipulated in the contract.
- 4. For the End- user, present clearly this TOR during the Pre- Bid Conference for the information of the prospective bidder/s (for Competitive/ Public Bidding), and present by the Buyer with the assistance of the End- user (for Alternative Methods of Procurement).
- Ensure that there are readily- available supplies upon submission of Request for Quotation (RFQ)/ Bid since delivery is anticipated upon issuance of PO/ Contract.
- Comply with the provisions of the Procurement Law regardless of the mode of procurement, whether Competitive/ Public Bidding or the use of Alternative Methods of Procurement.

c. Delivery/Implementation period

1. Strictly observe the "No Purchase Order (PO)/ Contracts, No Delivery" Policy and comply with the delivery period.

- 2. The Delivery Period shall be on April to December 2025.
- During the delivery, strictly follow the provisions enumerated in the Terms and Condition of the PO/ Contract including the Delivery Schedule, Penalty, among others.
- 4. In case there is a change in the Delivery Schedule and specifications, the End- user through the Procurement Officer shall coordinate with the CGSO-Procurement Management Division (PMD) for the latter to advise the supplier/contractor regarding the concern.
- Coordination with the supplier/ contractor shall be the function of the CGSO-PMD as its mandate.
- 6. For onsite delivery, ensure the coordination with the Inspector from the CGSO- Property and Supply Management Division (PSMD) for the inspection of the delivery in terms of quantity and quality of meals and to immediately notify the supplier/ contractor in case of any concerns before the acceptance.

d. Inspection and Acceptance

 The End- user shall accept the delivery with the (1) delivery receipts, and submit immediately to the Inspector or CGSO- PSMD together with the (2) attendance sheet/s as part of the utilization where the quantity of the delivery is the same as the number of attendees and photo documentation of the delivery.

Such documents will be used in notifying the concerned offices on the delivery such as the City Accountant's Office (CAccO) and Commission on Audit (COA) to include the same in the Payables.

V. DELIVERABLES BY THE SUPPLIER/ CONTRACTOR AND THE CITY GOVERNMENT

The deliverables of the supplier/ contractor shall be as follows:

- a. Provide the quantity of meals being required by the project/ program; and
- b. Strictly follow the specifications and timely provision of requirements based on the delivery schedule.

The deliverables of the City Government shall be as follows:

a. On- time payment of the supplier/ contractor i.e., 15 days after delivery regardless if the delivery is per month or Ordering Agreement.

- b. End- user shall monitor the delivery of requirements.
- c. The Procurement Officer shall assist in the monitoring, delivery and on-time payment of the supplier.
- d. Provide necessary and readily- available documents such as during the conduct of post- audit.
- e. Evaluate the performance of the supplier/ contractor and in case there is a violation to the Contract/ Agreement, prepare a Verified Report.
